From the south take Interstate 25 north and Exit 50 (RTE 160) then go west (left) into Walsenburg. Go left at the first light ((Main St) then right at then 2nd light (7th Avenue) and travel approximately 3 miles. Our facility is on the left on the Spanish Peaks Regional Health Center campus.

From the north take Interstate 25 south and Exit 52 (RTE 160) curve right (west) go into town and at the 2nd light (7th Avenue) turn right and travel approximately 3 miles. Our facility is on the left on the Spanish Peaks Regional Health Center campus.

Honorably discharged veterans, veterans' spouses or widows and "Gold-Star" parents who meet medical criteria are eligible for long-term or short-term in our Home.
